Stillness Before God

One of the most important things we can learn in this day and hour is how to be still.

I believe that one of the significant reasons so many of us are burned out and stressed out is that we don't know how to be still. We don't really know everything about God and do not always acknowledge Him. It's only by spending time getting to know Him that we learn to hear His still, small voice so that He can direct our paths.
