## Serving The World through Missions & Evangelism

God calls us to be active in sharing our faith.

To encourage you in sharing your faith, today we are going to look at three different motivations for evangelism found in the Bible: God's fame, our design, and others' need.

### God's Fame:

When we are sharing the gospel, we are giving praise to God. We are telling people about God's great love, His tender mercy, His uncompromising justice, and His sheer brilliance to devise a way to forgive us without being unjust. As we share the gospel, we make Him famous.

### Our Design:

As Christians we are Christ's ambassadors. The role and purpose of an ambassador is to live in a foreign country specifically to represent the interests of his or her home country. This means as Christ's ambassadors on earth, we are created to represent the interests of God's kingdom, which includes evangelism.

### Other's Need:

Jesus describes the lost as harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd.. The consequence of sin is death. Satan has blinded the minds of unbelievers. People are spiritually ready – The fields are ripe for harvest now. Jesus is the only way to the Father.

When you look at the community around you, knowing that there are so many people there who are lost and have never heard the Gospel, how do you respond? Evangelism is necessary. Unless someone hears the gospel, they cannot believe. Therefore we need to verbally share this good news with others.

Having looked at the biblical basis for sharing Jesus with others, how will this affect the way you use your time? If every Christian were actively engaged in helping others discover Jesus, how would our community change?

It is clear from Scripture that God uses us to bring Him praise and to invite others into His Kingdom. While we do not control the results, we can control whether we take the initiative to share Jesus with others. While we may still have fears when it comes to sharing our faith, the Holy Spirit can help us overcome these fears. We are not called to be perfect at evangelism, God simply asks us to be obedient – motivated by love for Him and compassion for others.
